- Know names such as Louis Pasteur and Jane Colden and how they impacted the world of Science today.



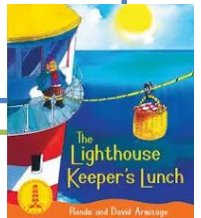
As Design Technicians we will...

- Practically tell the time and investigate with money.

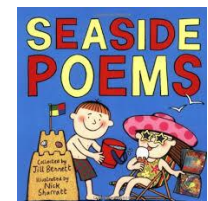


As mathematicians in Year 2 we will ...
