



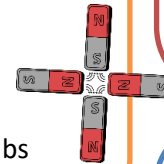
As historians we will...

- Explore how life changed for people during different periods of the Stone Age, including early middle and new Stone Ages.
- Investigate what archaeological evidence there is from this period and look in detail at the settlement Skara Brae and what conclusions can be drawn from the evidence found at the site.



As scientists we will...

- Look at magnets and their uses, and what makes magnetic poles special, along with the idea that some forces such as magnetic force can act without contact – unlike pushes and pulls, which require direct contact.
 - Investigate how things move on different surfaces.
- To know that friction is the resistance force encountered when one object or surface rubs against each other.



As artists we will...

- Explore prehistoric art, recreating the style of cave artists using charcoal and natural pigments.
- We will experiment with colour mixing and creating large scale artworks enhancing artistic skills as well as historical knowledge.



As readers we will...

- Develop our comprehension skills.
- Improve reading aloud - focussing on intonation, tone and volume.
- Develop our fluency within our Little Wandle reading groups.

As computer programmers we will...

- Understand the dangers of playing games and looking at online content.
- Know how to stay safe on devices.



As active learners we will...

- To recognise different areas of fitness and explore what your body can do.
- Develop the techniques of golf including accuracy of aiming at a target and understanding of techniques to use over long and short distances.

As Religion Researchers we will...

- Look at the importance of the River Ganges to Sanatanis and investigate the enquiry question
- “Does visiting the River Ganges make a person a better Sanatani?”

As mathematicians we will...

- Commence our topic on place value and understanding the value of each digit in a number.
- Within this topic, we will continue to develop our problem solving and reasoning skills.
- Strengthen our understanding of core arithmetic.



As writers we will...

- Study the book ‘Stone Age Boy’ by Satoshi Kitamura and ‘UG’ by Raymond Briggs looking at key vocabulary.
- Know the features of a diary entry, narrative and a letter and produce our own.
- Extend, edit and improve our writing.
