

## Life Cycle Craft

What to do: Make a life cycle wheel (e.g. butterfly or frog) using paper plates or circles.

Include: Egg → larva → pupa → butterfly (or frog cycle).


 Links to: understanding change over time

## Grow Your Own Seeds

What to do: Plant cress, beans, or sunflower seeds in a pot or even a yoghurt tub.

Talk about: What plants need to grow (sun, water, soil).

Extension: Draw or take photos each day to see changes.

 Links to: plant life cycles, observing change

## Minibeast Hunt

What to do: Go outside (garden/park) and look for bugs under leaves, logs, or stones.

Tip: Take photos or draw what you find.


Extension: Count how many different minibeasts you spot.

## Farm Animal Sorting Game

What to do: Use toy animals or pictures and sort into groups (baby/adult, farm/wild).

Challenge: Match baby animals to their parents (lamb–sheep, calf–cow).
